Objet: Public consultation of Master Plan

To whom it may concern:

I was unable to attend your public consultation of the Master Plan for Montreal, therefore I am writing to send you my various general suggestions for planning, primarily in my neighbourhood (Cotes-des-Neiges), but also more generally for the city. They are:

- 1) control air space in the city. I live on the mountain, which is a central feature of the city, both for residents and for visitors; planes should not be permitted to fly so low (and noisily) over what represents some of the most important green space in the city (space that is otherwise limited elsewhere in the city)
- 2) In addition improving transportation to the airport in Dorval, you should also consider transportation to Mirabel. I don't believe the Dorval airport will be able to handle of the air traffic in the long term as the city continues to grow
- 3) slow down traffic on Cotes-des-Neiges and consider putting in bike lanes
- 4) like Ottawa, Montreal should develop the capacity to carry bicycles on buses
- 5) have more community gardens

I applaud your efforts to publicize the master plan and to solicit public input into the plan.
