Re public consultation, I offer you my input:

- ① I am pleased that what I've heard is the biggest green space in Montreal, the St Jacques escarpment, is to be preserved. Very pleased. I'd be leery of "improved" tho - why not just green space improving wild bird habitat, air quality, & esthetics.
- ② I am not for making highways into tunnels. I think they are dangerous to drive in & also very unhealthy for the motorists & for the buildings & walkways on top. I wouldn't like to live on top of one. Also of course very expensive to build. Not even Toronto was greedy enough to tunnel-ize the Gardner Expressway!
- ③ The worst thing for the quality of life in NDG was/is expansion of the airport at Dorval. I think rapid transit should have made Mirabel more accessible also I think any further train traffic in NDG should be put ^{over} underground at least at intersections such as Elmhurst & Westminister. And there is already a rail link to Dorval & bus service to airport. This should be more public.
- ④ I am not in favor of increasing road traffic on Cavendish south of Cote St. Luc road. But why not look at making an overpass over the railway & connect the northern part with Parc since all those huge new buildings will be causing big traffic jams around Cote St. Luc & Hampstead?
