It was brought to our attention that the City of Montréal mandated the Office de consultation publique de Montréal (OCPM) to undertake a public consultation on the future and the principles of the development of the Bridge-Bonaventure sector.

For over 150 years, Catelli Foods Corporation has been a company involved in food processing. Located on Notre-Dame Street East, Catelli employs over 160 persons. Today Catelli continues the tradition by producing the best and most innovative pasta worldwide, ideal for traditional recipes as well for contemporary ones, most appreciated by Canadian families.

To operate our business, we need semolina made by the ADM plant in Montreal. Indeed ADM is one of the principal Catelli raw materials supplier.





Considering the potential for real estate development in the area and around the Mill Street ADM plant, we are particularly concerned about maintaining the accessibility conditions at the ADM plant. On a weekly basis, it is around 30 truckloads of semolina that Catelli receives. It is therefore important that the road network, open to trucking, be maintained on Mill Street and its surroundings in order to be able to access their facilities safely and efficiently.

According to the information provided to us by ADM, we understand that a potential residential development near the plant could affect the productivity of the plant and subsequently compromise their facilities in Quebec. We want to support ADM in its efforts to maintain its facilities and its operating conditions. The development choices that the City will eventually make will have an impact on the operations of our company.
