Service

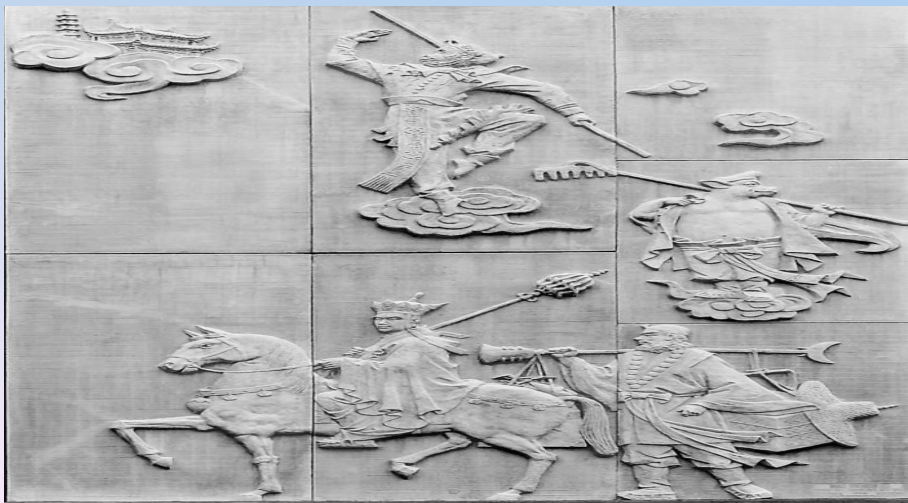
- From laundromat

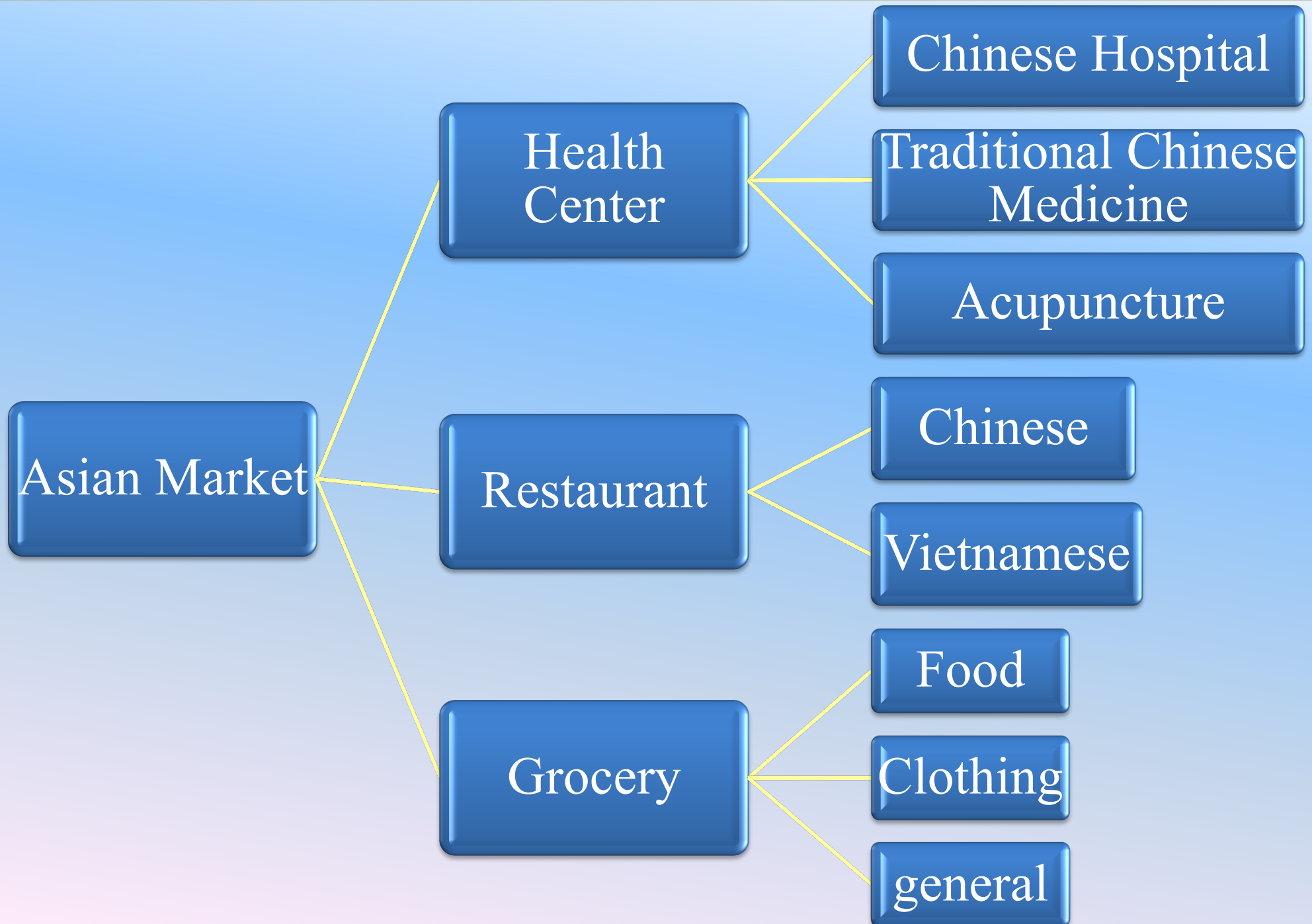

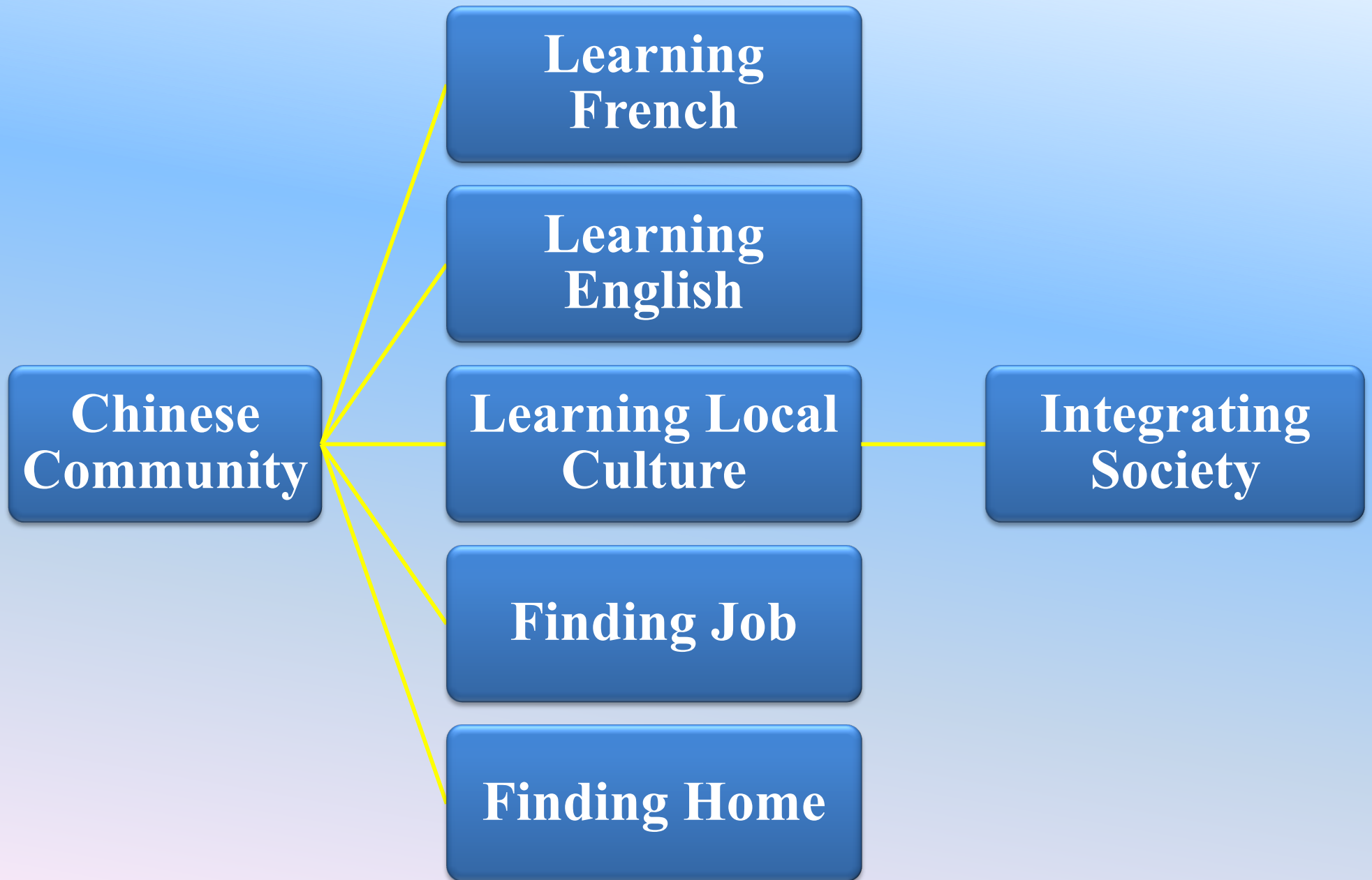

A block of Chinatown was destroyed



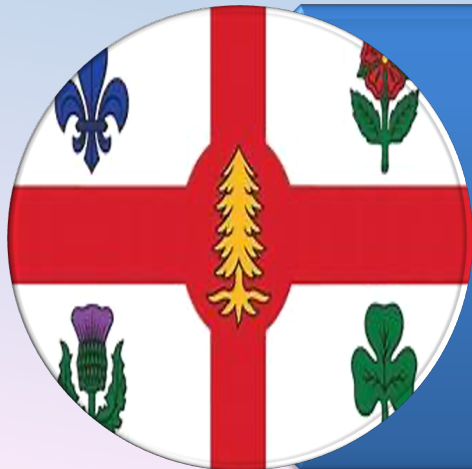
Additional buildings were harmed

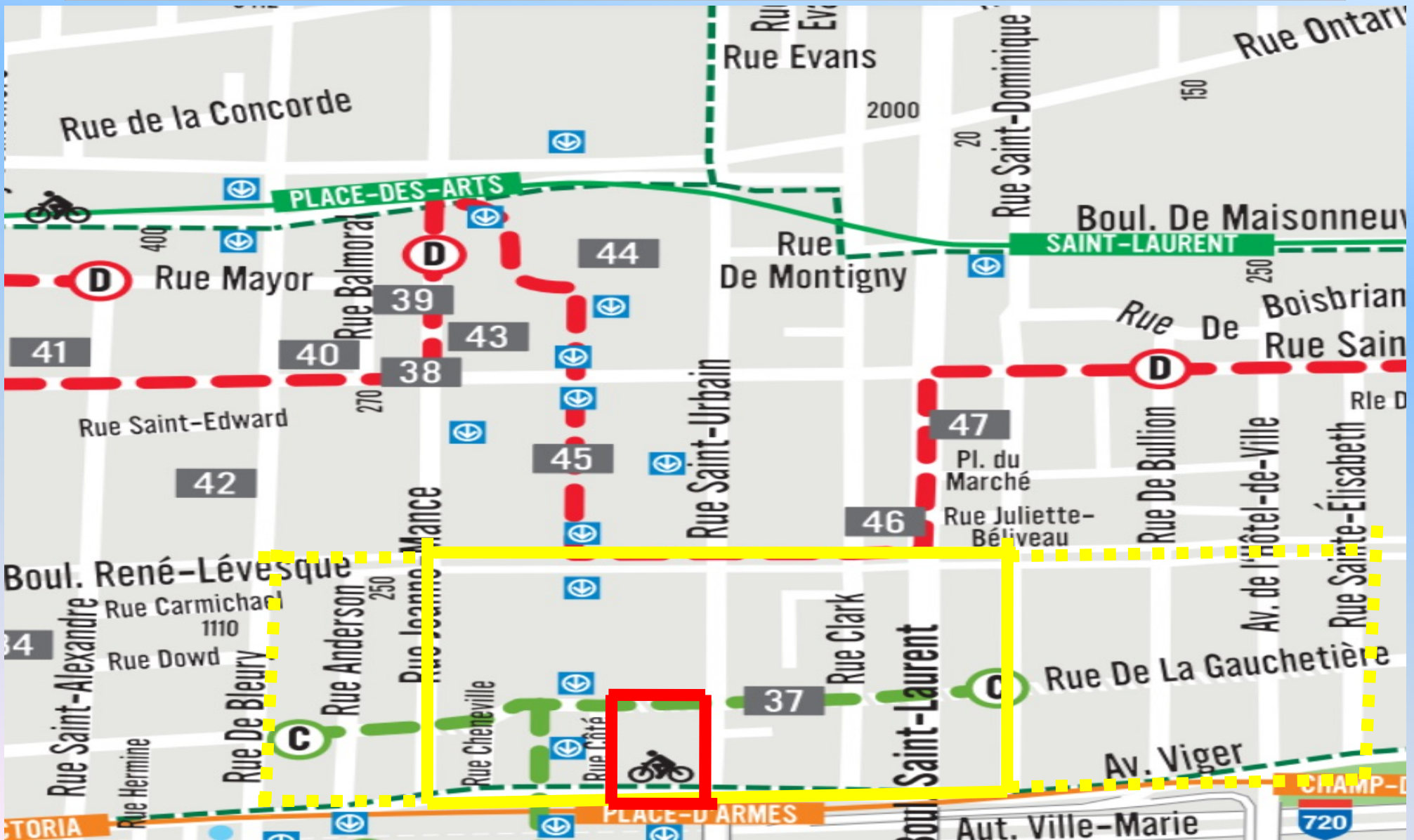
Core block designated as a Quebec historic heritage district

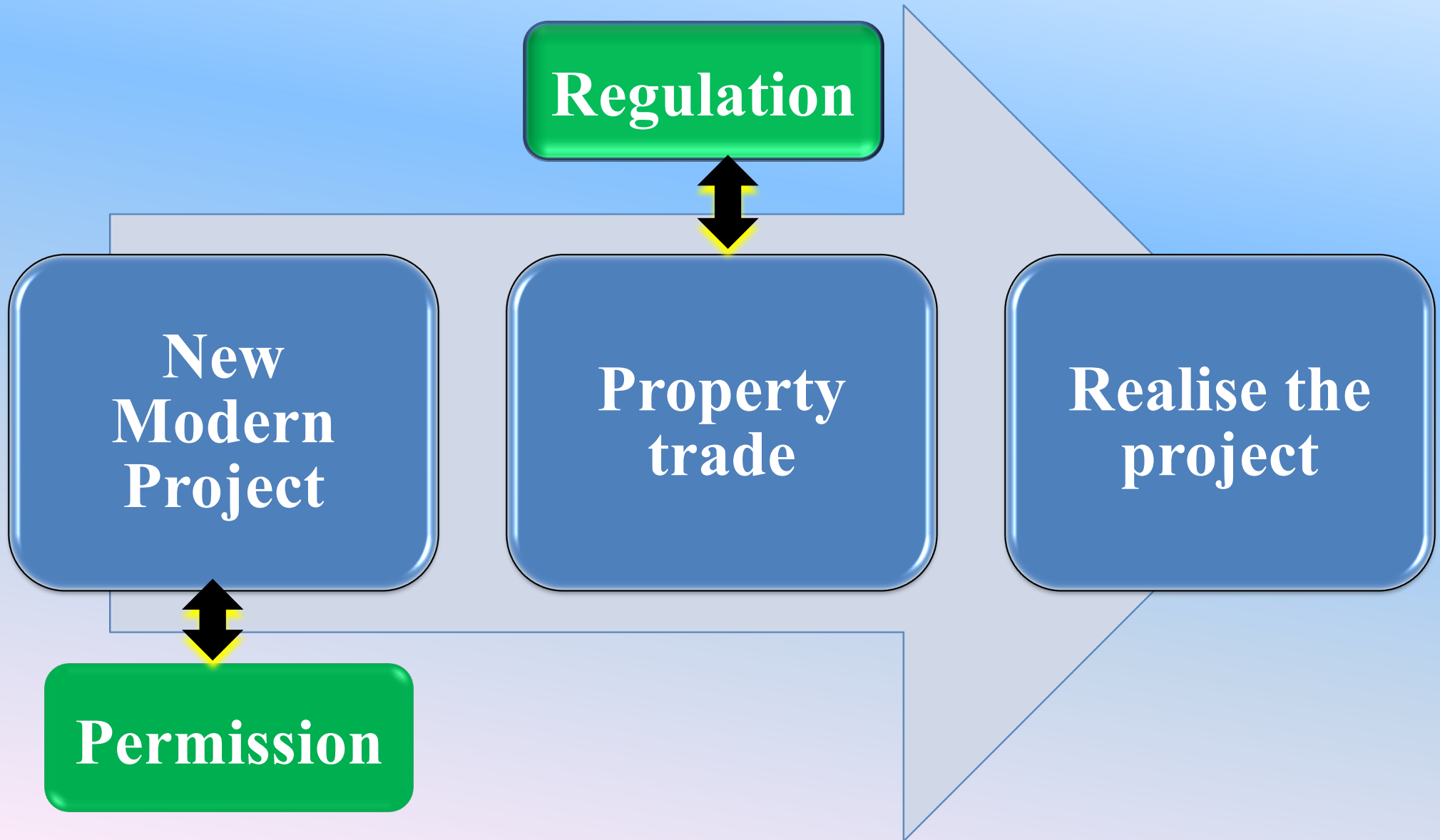
