To Psychologically guide woman to overcome gender differences and establish mechanisms in Society.

The findings provide support for the effectiveness of social disconnection interventions that involve actual interactions with community level organizations. These interventions targeted momentary vulnerabilities that arise from social exclusion by addressing negative affect and cognitions before or after they emerge. As such, they offer a promising approach to primary prevention prior to the onset of loneliness and social isolation.

1. Social Cohabitation

* Myth: Difference like caste, religion, racism, class, colour etc. can cause division in the Society.

* Reality! - If there is a feeling that everyone is human then no differences will arise in the Society.

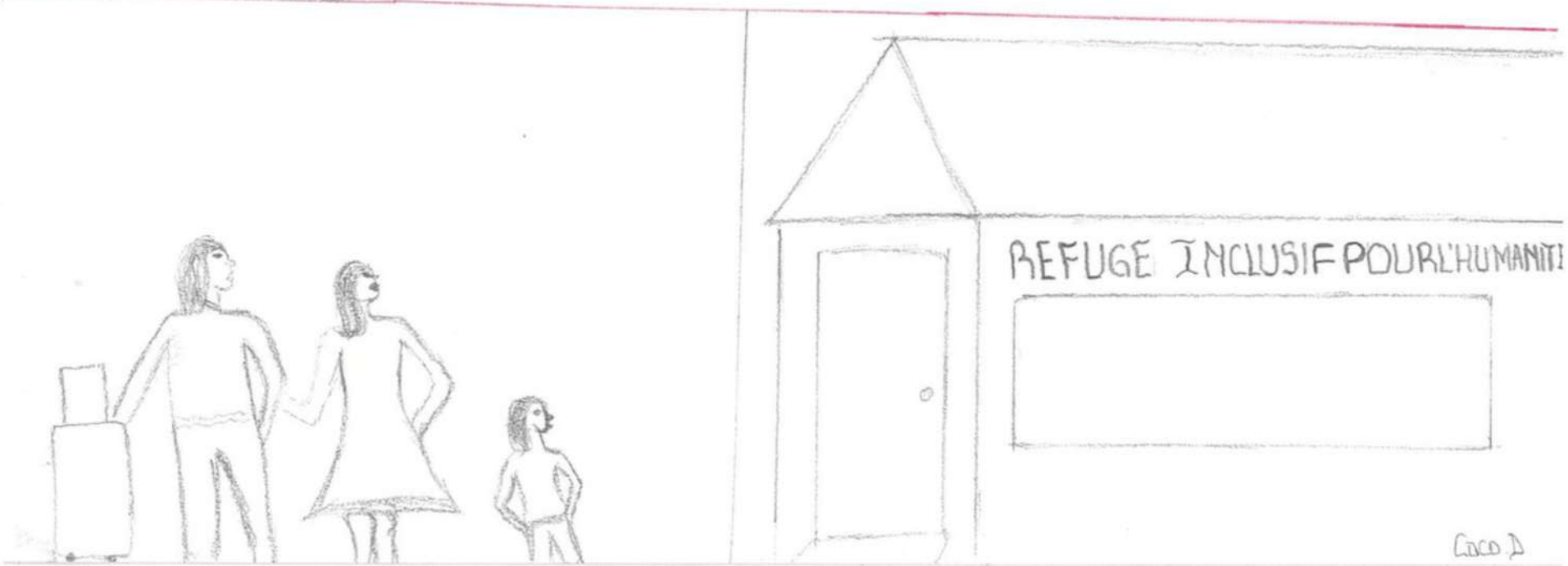
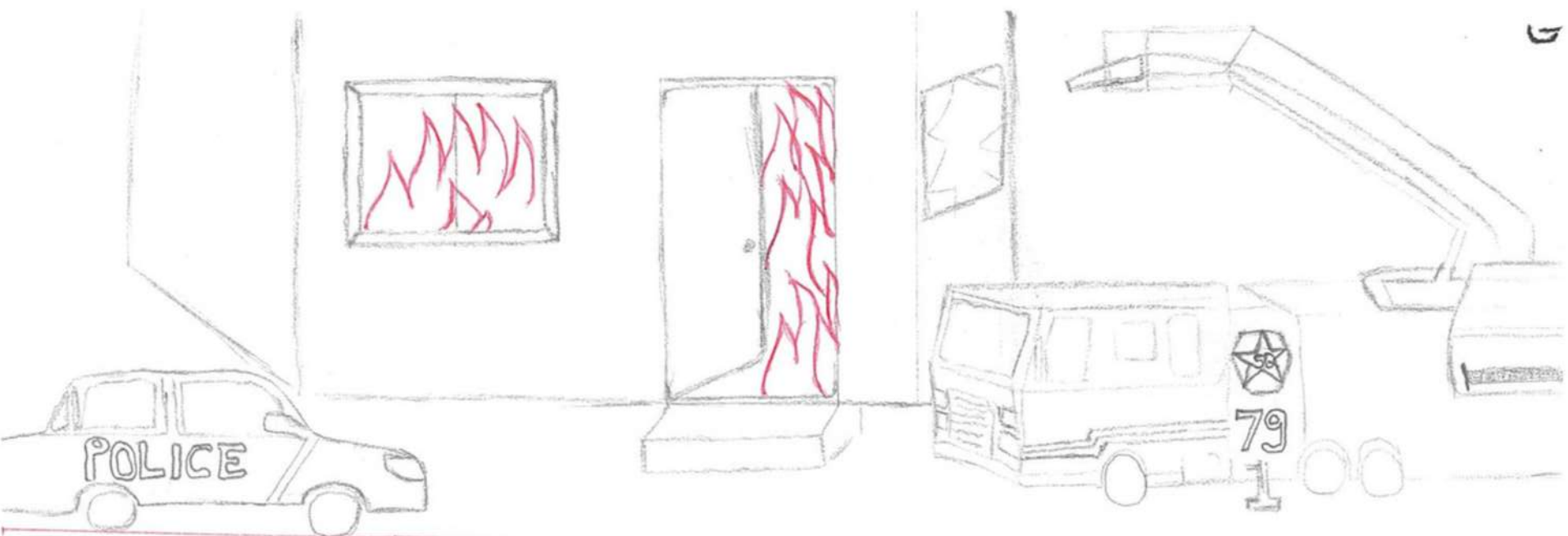
2. Social Exclusion

* Myth: They are excluded from Society because of their educational backwardness.

* Reality! - Identifying and encouraging their talents to absorb them into the Society will make the Society stronger.

3. To identify the marginalized people in the Society and create a awareness for the marginalized people to secure themselves.

4. Action of community level organizations to protect the rights of the physically, mentally and socially vulnerable people in the Society.

Would NEED A Warm Bed

Bonjour,

I am a woman in her 20s that found herself homeless unexpectedly. Before seeking temporary housing, I had my own reservations about the shelter system. These mirrored the misconceptions that 'normal' society places on the homeless. I was concerned that shelters might be a violent space, filled with people that had given up all hope of assimilation. The truth, however, couldn't have been more different.

I witnessed around me people that had little support. People that were struggling with mental health issues but not just that, with learning disabilities that make it impossible to put up with the demands of a fast-paced environment. Some had just experienced life-altering events that exacerbated their pre-existing challenges. All good people though that were trying their best.

My opinion of shelters changed when I personally found myself at one. Shelters offer people in precarious situations a safe space to be. They are a place that many associate with belonging.

A place to find community through shared struggles. A space to be honest about said struggles without being penalized for it.

It's true that the shelter system needs reform and things can be improved. However, the presence of shelters is not a nuisance to public. It's the lack of, that is the threat to all community. Opening of more shelter space is crucial to address the increasing rates of homelessness. A year ago, I wouldn't have thought that I would end up homeless. But, it is the new reality. Until a solution for housing shortage, economic crises and inflation is figured, the need for more temporary housing remains critical.
