

Public Consultation



The Ville de Montréal has mandated the Office de consultation publique de Montréal (OCPM) to hold a **public consultation on the development of the Peel Street entrance to Mount Royal in the « Serpentin » sector of Pine Avenue**, at the corner of Peel Street. Among the projected measures, there are plans for a more direct access to the new staircase on the escarpment, the installation of a distinctive main entrance to the staircase on Pine and the integration of art work. The renaturalization of degraded areas (notably to promote biodiversity) and work to take advantage of surface runoff are also planned.
