We envision that the cyclist and pedestrian Dalle Park bridge to be recognized as the world's leading green overpass by an exceptional innovative design. Such a monumental bridge and all its surrounding gardens would be another ideal tourist attraction and a pride of the cities multicultural communities.

The Bridge ought to be designed with the latest environmentally self sufficient technologies including plants for over pass and the surroundings to neutralize the Turcot car emissions, solar panels to supplement the bridge's electricity requirement, and many other modern features.
